24 channels house mixer digital console (Yamaha M7CL, DM 2000, CL1, CL3, CL5) STAGE:

8 monitors with separate sends for each musician (D&B Max, Martin, RCF. L Acoustic)

24-channel stage mixer – 8 independent sends

N.B. = Only in the event of an extreme emergency, the monitors can be piloted from the front desk but the official request is in any case related to a separately controllable and equalizable system.



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# LIGHT RIDER

### **Light Plot**

The production travels with lighting operator (Luca Devito +39 349 61 59 463) in tow.

Please provide for him a console CHAMSYS (NO QUICK SERIE) or alternatively MA2 or MA3 which will be placed in the center of 3/4 of the room and possibly next to the audio.

The lighting plan can adapt to the conditions of the venue and are welcome to any alternative that fits what is indicated, but every aspect must be agreed in advance and approved by the production.

For each musician, provide reading lights independent of lectern and dimmable.

Front Truss:  $1/2 25^{\circ}/50^{\circ}$  shapers for each of the musicians on stage + 6 parled with zoom Middle Truss: 4 spots

Rear Truss: 6 WashBeam + 3 Spot - the latter will be placed at the respective ends of the truss as pipe hand and at the center.

Floor: 15 Astera Titan Tube (alternatively Ax1); fixtures with strobe and pixel-mapping (minimum 4). Hazer

NB: a lighting assistant will have to take care of the aiming, be able to use the console and set the programming work on the ASTERA in advance and before the load-in; if this is not possible, please inform us as soon as possible.

# HOSPITALITY RIDER

### HOTEL

The basic hospitality request is for the accommodation of the musicians, the sound engineer and the tour manager in 8 (eight) DUS rooms in 4- or 5-star hotels (including breakfast) LOCAL TRANSPORTS

We ask for transportation on comfortable and spacious vehicles (avoid small cars because it would not be possible to transport instruments, electronic equipment and luggage) to and from stations and/or airports of arrival, venues, hotels, restaurants and vice versa.) Always keep in mind that musicians travel with their own personal luggage and with instruments and various effects.

### ROOMS

If possible, dressing rooms should be located close to the stage, in a safe or controlled area and with the possibility to lock every door.

We remind you that the organization is responsible for the safety of all valuables brought by musicians in the backstage area.

Dressing rooms must be clean, sanitized and comfortable and contain chairs, tables, mirrors, toilets with soap and towels in adequate numbers.

# CATERING

Coffee, soft drinks, juice, mineral water, at least a couple of bottles of quality dry red wine, beer, sandwiches and sandwiches, fruit. Catering must be available and stocked both during rehearsals and after the concert. DINNER

To be organized always BEFORE the concert in a quality restaurant with a choice of menu. Vegetarian menus should also be provided.
